

5.2 FY 23 Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP) – Amendment #1

• FY 23 UPWP Adopted February 2022

- Adjust FY 23 budget expenditures for studies: Raleigh-Fayetteville Passenger Rail Phase II Study; Southeast Area Study; BRT Extension Major Investment Study, and Mobility Management Implementation Study
- Increase FY 23 budget for US 401 Corridor Study
- Reflect FY 23 Wake Transit Work Plan budget including additional staff position for Wake Transit
- Federal transit planning funds for GoRaleigh to conduct BRT Station Area Planning and for GoTriangle to conduct Route Restoration planning work
- Budget adjustment for II-A-12 to bring that working line item from \$10,000 to \$15,000 to account for additional maintenance needs for the Non-Motorized Data Volume Count program data counters
- Adjustments to Tables 3, 4A and 4C to reflect these changes
- Increase Member Shares from \$0.578 to \$0.616 per capita to begin implementation of Strategic Plan & Organizational Study; total budget adjustment of approximately \$550,000
- Updates to the TCC Member list to reflect current membership at the time of Amendment adoption

Amendment #1 Schedule:

- September 2022 Review by TCC and Executive Board
- 30-Day Public Comment Period September 19 to October 18, 2022
 - No comments received to date
- October 2022 Recommend adoption by TCC; Consider adoption by Executive Board

Requested Action:

Recommend the Executive Board adopt Amendment #1 to the FY 23 UPWP.



5.3 Non-Motorized Volume Data Program (NMVDP) - Master Services Agreement

- This item is part of Amendment #1 to the FY 2023 UPWP, as presented to TCC & Executive Board in September/October
 - Budget adjustment from \$10,000 to \$15,000 to account for additional maintenance needs for NMVDP's data counters.
- NCDOT has transitioned the counter inventory to collaborating program agencies such as CAMPO and no longer supports the maintenance of the inventory.
- A Master Services Agreement has been written between CAMPO and ITRE to
 - Maintain the NMVDP counter inventory through onsite maintenance and assistance with a financial obligation for the services provided
 - Give a status report on the counters twice a year, along with presentations to the TCC and Executive Board
 - Provide CAMPO staff with a copy of the maintenance log quarterly, and email updates after site visits

1) Goals and objectives were simplified and clarified;


2) Enhanced guidance was added for lead agency staff project sponsors;
