

## **RESOLUTION TO CERTIFY THE GORALEIGH ACCESS COMPLEMENTARY ADA PARATRANSIT PLAN**

A motion was made by MPO Member \_\_\_\_\_ and seconded by MPO Member \_\_\_\_\_ for the adoption of the resolution; and upon being put to a vote was duly adopted.

**WHEREAS** the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) regulations require GoRaleigh, as a public entity that operates a fixed-route transit system, to provide complementary paratransit services to individuals with disabilities (that is, service that is comparable to the level of service provided to individuals without disabilities who use the fixed-route system); and

**WHEREAS** GoRaleigh provides these paratransit services and complies with the act, including all stipulations exhibited in Title 49 Code of Federal Regulations 37.139, and

**WHEREAS** one of the stipulations of the act requires GoRaleigh to obtain certification by the Metropolitan Planning Organization (CAMPO) that it has reviewed the plan and the plan is in conformance with the transportation plan developed under the Federal Transit/Federal Highway Administration's joint planning regulation ( 49 CFR part 613 and 23 CFR part 450), and

**WHEREAS** GoRaleigh received authorization from the Raleigh Transit Authority when the plan was adopted June 21, 2017, and

**WHEREAS** GoRaleigh coordinates its ADA services with GoTriangle, GoCary, and GoDurham and GoRaleigh's ADA paratransit services meet the six service criteria enumerated in Section 223 of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, and

**WHEREAS** CAMPO staff reviewed the plan and reports GoRaleigh's ADA Plan is consistent with and follows select goals and objectives of Connect 2045, the latest Metropolitan Transportation Plan for CAMPO including other statewide long-range transportation plans, and

**WHEREAS** the GoRaleigh Access 2017 Complementary ADA Paratransit Plan is in conformance with the required transportation plan, and

**WHEREAS** the TCC recommended approval to certify the GoRaleigh Access 2017 Complementary ADA Paratransit Plan at their June 7, 2018 meeting

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** that the members of the North Carolina Capital Area Metropolitan Planning Organization Board agrees to certify the GoRaleigh Access 2017 Complementary ADA Paratransit Plan.
