4.1 Minutes - May 14, 2026 Susan Owens, MPO Staff

Het Patel made a motion to approve the TCC Meeting Minutes of May 14, 2026. Bradley Kimbrell seconded the motion. The motion carried 35-0.

5. Regular Business

5.1 Triangle Mobility Hub LPA Approval

Catherine Miller, GoTriangle Project Manager

Requested Action: Recommend Executive Board approval of the Triangle Mobility Hub LPA site location

Catherine Miller, GoTriangle, provided an overview of the Triangle Mobility Hub (TMH), the Locally Preferred Alternative (LPA), the LPA approval process, and public engagement efforts and comments.

Travis Crayton made a motion to recommend Executive Board approval of the Triangle Mobility Hub LPA site location. Chris Garcia seconded the motion. The motion carried 35-0.

5.2 FY 2027 Wake Transit Work Plan and Project Agreement Groupings and Reporting Deliverables

Requested Action: Recommend the Executive Board 1) Approve the TPAC-recommended FY 2027 Wake Transit Work Plan; 2) Approve the proposed project agreement groupings and deliverables; and 3) Authorize the Executive Director to execute all FY 2027 Work Plan project-level agreements to which CAMPO is a party

Mr. Mott provided an overview of the FY 2027 Wake Transit Work Plan adoption schedule, the financial snapshot, operating investments, and capital investments. He summarized public engagement efforts, assets, results, themes, and key comment highlights. He provided background information on the FY 2027 Wake Transit Work Plan Project Agreement Groupings and Deliverables and provided deliverable examples.

Conrad Olmedo made a motion to recommend Executive Board 1) approval of the TPAC-recommended FY 2027 Wake Transit Work Plan; 2) approval of the proposed project agreement groupings and deliverables; and 3) authorization for the Executive Director to execute all FY 2027 Work Plan project-level agreements to which CAMPO is a party. Bret Martin seconded the motion. The motion carried 35-0.

5.3 Triangle Bikeway East Design Project Alternatives Analysis

Requested Action: Recommend Executive Board endorsement of the technical recommendation alignment for the Triangle Bikeway East Design Project to carry forward to 30% design completion

Ms. Russell provided a status update on the Triangle Bikeway East Design Project preliminary design and an overview of the progress to date and next steps. She summarized the Alternatives Analysis, providing an overview of the methodology, RTP Area alternatives and public input received, Lake Crabtree Area alternatives and public input received, Wade Avenue Area alternatives and public input received, and the final alignments.

Travis Crayton made a motion to recommend Executive Board endorsement of the technical recommendation alignment for the Triangle Bikeway East Design Project to carry forward to 30% design completion. Sandi Bailey seconded the motion. The motion carried 35-0.

5.4 Locally Administered Projects Program (LAPP) FFY2028 Target Modal Mix

Requested Action: Receive as information

Ms. Samayoa provided an overview of the Locally Administered Projects Program (LAPP) FFY2028 Target Modal Mix, noting the August 2026 Call for Projects, proposed LAPP funding increase, LAPP Guidebook improvements, Blueprint for Safety influences on LAPP scoring, considerations of the local match criteria on LAPP scoring, rolling stock as eligible projects, and next steps towards an August 2026 approval and One-Call-for-All.

Responding to Conrad Olmedo's question regarding the scheduling of the TCC recommendation during the public comment period, Ms. Samayoa stated that this schedule follows previous years. We can speak internally about tweaks. She noted that pre-submittal meetings are scheduled for September/October 2026.

Chris Lukasina added that the proposed schedule is standard protocol for TCC. The Executive Board can take into account any further technical recommendations and public comments received prior to their approval.

5.5 Amendment #4 to FY 2026-2035 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)

Chris Lukasina presented the item on behalf of Mr. Rickard, providing an overview of Amendment #4 to the FY 2026-2035 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) and next steps towards an August 2026 approval.

5.6 SPOT 8 Update - Statewide Programming & Regional Impact Target Modal Mixes

Daniel Spruill, MPO Staff

Requested Action: Recommend Executive Board approval of Regional Impact target modal mix

Mr. Spruill provided an overview of the SPOT program and the evolution of the prioritization process, the approval schedule, STI Programming Process tiers, Division and region maps, STIP funding distributions, the revised P8 schedule and where we are at, draft Statewide programming, project development influence, local input points, and funding availabilities for the STI funding categories.

Chris Lukasina commented that last year there were seven more negative numbers on the Draft STIP Estimated Funding Availability List and that there had been a lot of discussion in the State about them.

Mr. Spruill continued by providing a summary of the recommended P8 Modal Allocation, non-highway funding competition, CAMPO's adopted methodology for assigning local input points and maximizing funding potential, STI-Region C projected funding versus submitted need, and the Regional impact target modal mixes.

Responding to Bret Martin, Mr. Spruill stated that the regional impact scores became available last Thursday and that Staff is still reviewing them and working with NCDOT.

Chris Lukasina added that the scores will be posted on CAMPO's website.

Responding to David Keilson's inquiry as to whether 300 public transportation points and 600 rail points were enough for the regional tier, Mr. Spruill stated that CAMPO limits project submissions to those most likely to be funded, no matter how excellent a project is.

Chris Lukasina added that this item is only recommending the target modal mixes. Later, with more discussion, we may recommend different point allocations. The recommended mixes will be used as a guide as we assess projects.

Mr. Spruill also added that we are still waiting for the non-highway category funding availabilities, expected in mid-June, which can also impact the final mix.

Responding to Het Patel, Mr. Lukasina stated that the recommended mix percentages are not the same as other rounds, but they create a good starting point.

Matt Day made a motion to recommend Executive Board approval of the Regional Impact target modal mix. Thanh Schado seconded the motion. The motion carried 35-0.

Chris Lukasina reported the following:

- *CAMPO received the Collaboration Award from the NC Traffic Safety Conference and Expo. He noted that implementation of the Blueprint for Safety Plan included a lot of collaboration and that there was more to come.*
- *There is new federal rulemaking happening regarding uniform grant regulations and what federal funds can be used for. The public comment period ends July 13, 2026. The changes will affect federal funding of all types, not just transportation. Take a look at them and pass along. This is the largest change to federal funding rules in a long time.*

David Keilson reported that the new TIMS system is now online and that it allows you to drill down in further detail.

NCDOT Division 6:

Robert Stone stated that a complete project listing was included in the Agenda.

*NCDOT Division 8:**No report provided.**Thanh Schado commented that Division 8 is waiting for an Engineer to be hired to replace Bryan Kluchar.**NCDOT Rail Division:**No report provided.**NC Turnpike Authority:**Alan Shapiro reported that the closure and detour of East Garner Road is now planned to start July 6, 2026. It will be for 45 days, possibly less, and further updates will be provided.**NCDOT Integrated Mobility Division:**Johnna Burkett introduced herself as the new Eastern Piedmont Regional Planner.**TCC Members:**Conrad Olmedo reported that HB 369 passed unanimously. It proposes a prohibition on regulations regarding off-street parking and requirements for a minimum number of parking spaces. This may shift parking onto rights-of-ways (ROW) and affect local ordinances and ROW use.**Aaron Gunderson reported that the Town of Zebulon Commission just allowed Staff to negotiate with our top finalist for the Small Area Plan.**Bret Martin commented to not confuse the proposed uniform guidance updates mentioned by Mr. Lukasina with the individual rules every federal program has. Those rules, including the issue of how funding is directed, is separate from the issue of grants management allowable expenses. He added that the proposed updates are being done by an entity other than USDOT.**Thanh Schado reported that Chatham County is hiring a consultant for their Haw River Trail Feasibility Study and that any neighboring jurisdictions that want to be a part of that can email her to be added to the stakeholder group.***9. Adjournment***Chair Tracy Stephenson adjourned the meeting at 11:00 a.m.*
